School-Wide Discipline Plan

LEVEL 1

- Level 1 behaviours are handled by the classroom teacher.

- Chronic Level 1 behaviours (defined as regular, repeated, and frequent behaviours over a short period of time) could result in parent/guardian contact and a referral to the school administration.

(Depending on the circumstances and seriousness of the offense, the student may have a verbal warning, a time out, a loss of privilege, a community service assignment, some form of restitution, an action plan, restricted recesses, etc.).

Here are some examples of choices that may show a lack of Respect for Self, for Others, for School, for Property, or for Community:

- Assembly behaviour
- · Damaging school property
- Disrespect toward other students
- Hallway behaviour
- Incomplete homework/assignments
- Invasion of personal space
- Inappropriate language

- Litter
- Misuse of electronic devices
- Refusing to follow directions
- Playground issues
- Pushing
- Unprepared for class
- · Wandering halls during class time

LEVEL 2

- Level 2 behaviours are handled by the classroom teacher.

- Chronic Level 2 behaviours (defined as regular, repeated, and frequent behaviours over a short period of time) will result in a referral to the school administration and parents/guardians will be contacted.

(Depending on the circumstances and seriousness of the offense, the student may have a verbal warning, a time out, a loss of privilege, a community service assignment, some form of restitution, an action plan, restricted recesses, an in-school suspension, etc.). Here are some examples of choices that may show a lack of Respect for Self, for Others, for School, for Property, or for Community:

- Abuse of school equipment
- · Bullying others
- Cheating/plagiarism
- Defacing school property
- Inappropriate clothing
- Inappropriate internet Sites
- Inappropriate representation of school (field trips, sports, etc.)
- Inappropriate print material
- Lying
- Opposition to authority
- Refusal to follow school rules
- Rough play/rough-housing
- Rude behaviours toward others
- Social alienation
- Teasing/derogatory remarks/gossip/put-downs

LEVEL 3

Level 3 behaviours will result in an immediate referral to the school administration.
Parents/guardians will be contacted.

(Depending on the circumstances and seriousness of the offense, the student may have a loss of privilege, a community service assignment, some form of restitution, an action plan, restricted recesses, an in-school suspension, an out-of-school suspension, etc.). Here are some examples of choices that may show a lack of Respect for Self, for Others, for School, for Property, or for Community:

- Defiance
- Fighting
- Intimidation/threats
- Intentional swearing directed at another person
- Physical aggression
- Racial and other derogatory remarks
- Gross misconduct

- Repeated bullying/intimidation
- Safety concern (dangerous)
- Sexual behaviour/harassment
- Theft
- Vandalism
- Weapons
