LEVEL 1

- Level 1 behaviours are handled by the classroom teacher.

- Chronic Level 1 behaviours (defined as regular, repeated, and frequent behaviours over a short period of time) could result in parent/guardian contact and a referral to the school administration.

(Depending on the circumstances and seriousness of the offense, the student may have a verbal warning, a time out, a loss of privilege, a community service assignment, some form of restitution, an action plan, restricted recesses, etc.).

Here are some examples of choices that may show a lack of Respect for Self, for Others, for School, for Property, or for Community:

LEVEL 2

- Level 2 behaviours are handled by the classroom teacher.

- Chronic Level 2 behaviours (defined as regular, repeated, and frequent behaviours over a short period of time) will result in a referral to the school administration and parents/guardians will be contacted.

(Depending on the circumstances and seriousness of the offense, the student may have a verbal warning, a time out, a loss of privilege, a community service assignment, some form of restitution, an action plan, restricted recesses, an in-school suspension, etc.). **Here are some examples of choices that may show a lack of Respect for Self, for Others, for School, for Property, or for Community:**
